## YMCA of Sumter GUEST POLICY

The following is protocol on acceptance for all non-member guests. All guests 18+ must have state ID or driver's license.

### Visit with Member

- **1<sup>st</sup> Visit:** There is no fee for a first-time guest of an active Sumter Family YMCA member. The member bringing in the guest must be at least 18 years old.
- **Additional Visits with Member:** After the first free visit, each additional visit with a Member will incur a \$10 fee. The member bringing in the guest must have an active Sumter Family YMCA membership and be at least 18 years old. NO LIMIT.
- **Guest Pass without Member:** The Sumter Family YMCA is a member-based organization. A fee of \$25 per visit must be paid to enter as a guest without a member. This pass does not allow access to our Health Service amenities. NO LIMIT.
- **Try The Y**
  - **Individual/Family Day Pass - \$20:** This option is for any individual (age 18+) or family (2 adults + dependents) who wants to try the Y before joining. Limit ONE time per calendar year. This pass allows access to our Health Service amenities for ages 18+ and Childwatch services for registered dependents ages 6 weeks - 11 years old.
  - **Individual Week Pass - \$40:** This pass is for one individual (age 18+) who wants to try the Y before joining. Limit ONE time per calendar year. This pass allows access to our Health Service amenities for ages 18+.
  - **Couple/Family Week Pass - \$50:** This option is for any adult couple (age 18+) or family (2 adults + dependents) who wants to try the Y before joining. Limit ONE time per calendar year. This pass allows access to our Health Service amenities for ages 18+ and Childwatch services for registered dependents ages 6 weeks - 11 years old.
- **Y Members:** We honor the memberships of those who are part of a YMCA. Membership verification is required. Nationwide members do not have a limit. Members of YMCAs that do not participate in Nationwide must provide contact information for the Y of which they are a member. Limit 5 visits per month.

### NATIONWIDE FAQ:

- Nationwide members **do not** have health service access and not permitted to bring in guests since they are considered guests of our Y.
- Those with a **verified family membership** may utilize our facility, including our Childwatch program.

### Requirements:

- All guest over the age of 18 must present a valid state ID or driver's license.
- Members must remain in the facility with their guest. If the guest is under 12 years old, the member must remain with the guest at all times.
- Sex offender screening is completed on all guests over 16 years old.
- If a guest would like to join within 30 days of their last visit, they will not be required to pay a joining fee.
